Grievence procedure: Minor changes still need to be made. Discussion tabled  
until next meeting. In the meantime the OM Team will use its  
best judgement. This was agreed to by all present.

Highway up-date: The highway will go through the originally proposed Southern  
routenext to the train tracks rather than through our oldest  
trees and the significant archiological sites. Construction is  
scheduled to begin sometime in 1986.

Saturday Market: Negotiations on the co-operative community venture of a  
Christmas Fair continue.

Construction up-date: ANY construction or reconstruction of lofts needs to be  
checked out with Douglas or Ed.

House bill report: Since it has been less than ninty days since the bill  
passed requiring permits for large gatherings, this years fair  
is not affected. We will see what happens judicially in the future.

Land access: Due to a presentation made by Michael, a vendor and former mem-  
ber of the board of directors of SaturdayMarket, Brian moved  
that we amend the camping policy to include staying on Wednesday

and Monday and contributing 3 hours of labor for this. John seconded the motion. POINT OF INTEREST: It is possible to make prior arrangements in such matters in order to avoid undue hardship. DISCUSSION HIGHLIGHTS: problems with liability insurance, extending services and hence increasing expenses without adding revenue, increasing load on already extended crews, the values of personal freedom and responsibility, non-co-operation of non-vendor folks, Patti called the question: motion to call the question failed by a vote of 5-4. Discussion continued. Mary suggested that the annual meeting in September be held on the site and that perhaps a barter fair could be held in conjunction with the meeting. General agreement that this was a good suggestion to pursue. John withdrew his second and the motion died.

Frank asked that recognition and appreciation be given to David Hoffman for his work on the lawns at Energy Park, Community Village and Shady Grove, and to Santos and Fred Silvestri for their work on the lawns inside the loop.

We still need volunteers to help with clean-up after the fair. Contact Douglas
